

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

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UK Government market dynamics

- History of successful outsourcing in UK public sector
- Belief in competition and the role of the private sector
- Increasingly decisions oriented to value for money = lowest price
- Timing may have an impact
 - Sizeable budget deficit
 - PFI/capital programmes may be postponed or scrapped
 - Limits on discretionary and variation spend
 - Drives need for reconfiguration of public services - expanded outsourcing & new outsourcing
 - Likely to change mix - greater focus on BPO / Asset sales
- Complex bidding processes requiring major bid expertise & skills
- Anticipate union opposition
- Impact of the General Election

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G4S UK Government strategy

Vision: To become the market leader in securing and managing critical services and facilities for Governments in the UK and in selected hostile environments

Deliver the basics





Justice

Prisons

- UK – manage four prisons
- South Africa – manage one prison
- Abu Dhabi – Education provision in one prison
- Australia – manage two prisons

Immigration Services

- UK - manage four removal centres; undertake > 78,000 escorted journeys pa
- USA - transportation & security services for 7 Southwest Border Patrol Sectors
- Netherlands - manage six removal centres, with > 3,500 detainees

Electronic Monitoring

- UK - > 40,000 subjects
- USA - 26,000 subjects
- Israel - 1,000 subjects
- New Zealand - > 3,000 subjects
- Australia - 331 subjects
- Northern Ireland - 190 subjects
- Netherlands - 194 subjects
- Austria - Tagging pilot completed for Ministry of Justice

Secure Training Centres

Court Services

- **UK** - run contract for two of the four contracted areas: North & East of England,
escorting > 530,000 offenders a year
 - manage Manchester Magistrates Court
- **Ireland** - manage Dublin Criminal Court
- **Australia** - manage courts for South & Western Australia and Victoria
 - manage Victorian County Court

Police Services

- **UK** - manage/operate 30 custody suites and 500 police cells: Lancs, South Wales & Staffs
 - provide temporary police staffing through 17,000 former police officers on our Policing Solutions database
 - Forensic medical services to four police forces
- **Iraq** - police mentoring
- **Afghanistan** - police mentoring
- **Bermuda** - police training
- **Guernsey** - policing solutions

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Exporting the Government model

Case Study – United Arab Emirates

- UK Justice works closely with G4S UAE team
- G4S providing input to the Ministry of Interior Committee recommending changes in law necessary to outsource Justice services in the region
- No current justice services competitors in the region
- Recent contract wins
 - Al Wathba prison
 - Education and rehabilitation services for 250 UAE offenders
 - Mobilised Sept 2009 / £2.4m annual operating contract value
 - Al Mafraq
 - Operation of a juvenile detention facility for 60 boys
 - Mobilised Oct 2009 / £3.1m annual operating contract value

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

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
Recent UK Government new wins

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UK bid pipeline – extracts

Major rebids

- Detention & Escorting - £40m pa – submission date end April 2010
- Prisoner Escort and Custody - £35m pa for each region for 10 years
- Dungavel - £5m pa for up to 8 years

Ministry of Justice

- Two 1500 bed PFI prisons each worth £25-30m pa for 25 years.
- Market testing five existing prisons – £10-20m pa for 10+ years.
- NOMS Unpaid Work - £25m pa for 5 years
- Glen Parva STC - £10m pa for 15 years
- Court Escorting (Scotland) - £10m pa for 5 years
- Min of Justice FM - £8m pa for 3 years

Police

- Gloucester Divisional Headquarter and Police Custody - £1.7m pa for 30 years
- Cleveland Police - sub-contractor to Steria - £4m pa for 10 years

Justice international pipeline

Prisons

- **New Zealand** – Potential PPP prison bid and remand centre
- **South Africa** - 5 new prisons are to be built by 2012
- **Bulgaria** - 2 new prisons in discussions to be built by 2012
- **Cyprus** – PPP prison

Electronic Monitoring

- **Hungary** – 20 subjects to start June 2010
- **Bulgaria** – initial small trial underway: tender for > 100 due Q2
- **Austria** – tender for 250 units due Q2
- **Nigeria** – tender for > 100 units due Q4
- **Saudi Arabia** – Q3

Other relevant

- **Israel** - Bidding for \$150m Police Academy PPP
